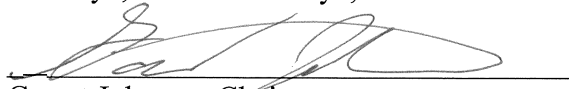

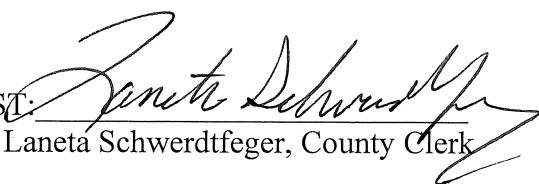

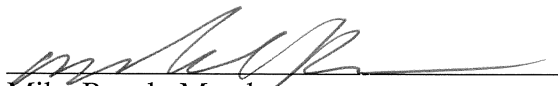
Legislative Update – Ross stated that most of the bills that came out of committee were positive for counties; the bill for no State sales-tax for groceries passed – will have to make up that amount somewhere; SB1403 – taking the cap off of motor-vehicle tax passed out of committee; SB1512 – commissioners to use equipment clarification – passed out of committee; HB1391 – 90 days for retirees to return to the county passed out of committee; HB3769 assault on county employees passed out of committee; HB3763 burn ban signs in right-of-way passed out of committee; HB3054 gas pipelines didn’t change the wording passed out of committee; and the Resale Funds – no one claims the funds it goes to the state passed out of committee.

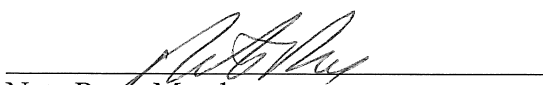
There was no Unforeseen Business (Any matter not known about or which could not have been reasonably foreseen prior to the time of posting and which is not an emergency)
