Johnson moved to approve the Private Property Access Easement for Dist #3 for NE ¼ of 26-26-11 to clean out creek channel and Roach seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Johnson moved to approve the Private Property Access Easement for Dist #3 for SE ¼ of 9-24-11 to clean out creek channel and Roach seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.


Johnson moved to approve the Clifford Power quote for block heater and heater hoses for the cooling system in the Courthouse for \$3,939.28 and Roach seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Johnson moved to approve the Transfer of Appropriations for Treasurer from Treasurer Personal Services 0001-1-0600-1110 to Treasurer M&O 0001-1-0600-2005 for \$1,115.00 for end-of-year expenses and Roach seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.


Discuss Estimate of Needs for FY 26-27 - Ross asked if anyone had talked to any of the entities helping with 911. Roach stated he had spoke with several entities: City of Cherokee would help with \$60,000.00; Jim Dykes said Helena and Goltry could possibly help so he is trying to get on their agenda for \$60,000.00; Roger Unrh with EMS said to email him his request for helping with \$60,000.00; he stated he spoke with Clint Ream and possibly each fire department helping with \$5,000.00 for a total of \$45,000.00. Roach stated that Wagner would go back to a dispatcher, they could move Gary Mast over 911 as the supervisor; each shift would have two dispatchers and a jailer; and Mast would cut \$118,000.00 out of his budget. Schwerdtfeger stated if there would be two dispatchers and a jailer on each shift that would increase the salaries for 911. Roach changed his plan to one dispatcher and one jailer on each shift, the cross training would be enforced since it should already have been done. Roach stated he talked to Buddy Carroll and he is on board with this, Carroll told Roach there would need to be a contract for all entities drawn up. Roach stated these groups being asked to pay for 911 is one way of keeping 911 here, he said 911 does a good job and they have the larger budget for County General so they have to start somewhere.
