Roach moved to approve the Monthly Highway Expenditures and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Roach moved to approve the Allocation of Alcohol Beverage Tax and Allocation of Motor Vehicle Tax and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Open Six-Month Bids – bids were received from Kirby Smith, Enid Concrete, Wright Asphalt, Yellowhouse, Dub Ross, Cummins Construction, Warren Cat, Hoskins, Ergon Asphalt, US Gypsum, Asphalt Fuel & Supply, Sunbelt, Fensco Inc, Vance Brothers, Coastal Energy, Arcosa Specialty, Railroad Yard, Logan County, and Dolese. Roach moved to accept the opened six-month bids and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Roach moved to approve the Transfer from Sheriff Cash M&O 1226-2-0400-2005 to Sheriff Cash Personal Services 1226-2-0400-1110 for \$28,000.00 and Sheriff Capital Outlay 0001-2-0400-4110 to Sheriff Personal Services 0001-2-0400-1110 for \$11,000.00 for funds for salaries for remainder of fiscal year and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Roach moved to approve the Transfer from Fairgrounds M&O 1310-4-8048-2005 to Fairgrounds Capital Outlay 1310-4-8048-4110 for funds for skid steer and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Roach Voted to Enter at 9:18 AM into Executive Session as Allowed by Oklahoma State Statues Title 25, Section 307, Paragraph B 1 (Discussing the employment, hiring, appointment, promotions, demotion, disciplining or resignation of any individual salaried public officer or employee) discuss employment of Maintenance Position and Purchasing Agent and Johnson seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Roach Voted at 9:23 to Re-Enter Regular Session and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Ross moved to Take No Action regarding executive session – discussion of employment of Maintenance Position and Purchasing Agent and re-evaluate in six months and Johnson seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Roach moved to approve the Cooperative Agreement for FY 2024-2025 for predator & rodent control in Alfalfa County and increased invoice of \$3,400.00 (\$1,000.00 per year) and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Roach moved to approve the Education Authority Draft Audit Report for 2021, 2022, and 2023; agreements from audits; questions on audit; and financial statements for Education Authority and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.

Before adjournment – Irvin asked if she could speak. She asked if the highway departments had received a raise, but they could not help ten deputies in the courthouse received a raise. She asked if they felt like they didn't deserve a raise also, they had not received a raise since 2016. Ross stated he had made \$160,000.00 in cuts in his district; Johnson stated had lowered his number of employees by four; and Roach stated he had reduced his payroll by \$30,000.00 by people retiring. Roach stated ARPA has saved the county the past couple of years but what was we going to do with it over. Johnson and Ross both stated that the deputies do deserve a raise but it is just not in the budget.

There was no Unforeseen Business (Any matter not known about or which could not have been reasonably foreseen prior to the time of posting and which is not an emergency)

Roach moved to Adjourn and Ross seconded. Johnson voted aye, Roach voted aye, and Ross voted aye.
