CDL Training – Ross stated at ACCO, Dale Frech stated all county's were having CDL driver shortage, he was trying to figure out, he stated some of the counties had been working with some of the DA's to get a contract, Ross stated it was costing anywhere from \$5,000 to \$10,000 to get a CDL, Frech said some DA's were working on a contract to sign for the employee to work for the county for two years or have to pay the county back. Ross stated with the county being an "At-Will Employer" he didn't know how this would fall into place, Roach stated he wanted long time employees to not have to sign a contract because things happen that were out of control in people's lives, he wanted only new hires to have to sign the contract, Schwerdtfeger asked if this would be discrimination? Ross said Frech was going to keep working and forward a contract when the DA's of those counties had one available.

Emergency Manager's Office was discussed, Ross stated other counties had a large room for the items donated for the Emergency Manager for the fire departments items, Johnson stated needed to have plumbing in the building, he also stated he liked having a large room, Roach stated the EM could have the LEPC meetings there, he stated he would add plumbing to a written quote and get three quotes for that also he had couple for the framing in, dropping the ceiling, and heat/air units. Miller stated there were bathrooms in the courthouse and an office for the EM in the courthouse so they could keep the workout room, she stated the whole county could benefit from the workout room if we were trying to cut benefits this was contradicting ourselves if we spend money on another office. The discussion continued and wanted to see how much the quotes would be.
