Part-time employee for 911 - Wagner stated that she had filled the full-time position that had been lost, but she was needing part-time position to help fill for an employee leaving on FMLA, the other employees had help out as much as they could but was getting into time for vacations. Hague asked if she had it in her budget, she said yes until the end of June. She said she had it in her budget for \$10.00/hour. Roach stated someone was giving them the fill dirt and someone was hauling off what they didn't take to Wilber's. Hague stated they had wanted to burn it but the EPA would not allow that, so this was the most economical way to get rid of it.
